Interested in refreshing your diving skills before a big dive trip, getting back into scuba diving after a few years off, or upgrading your Junior certification to an Open Water Diver certification? This flyer will give you information to get you signed up for a class and help inform you about our Refresher / Inactive Diver / Junior Diver upgrade course, Aqua Ventures and our certification agency (SDI). The attachments include a course application, a medical history questionnaire and guidelines and if needed a physician's evaluation form. Please spend some time reading through everything carefully. You are more than welcome to call us with any questions or concerns you may have about our refresher class or other diving related questions.

Refresher / Inactive Diver / Junior Diver upgrade course: \$120 / person

The course includes: The online SDI eLearning refresher materials, use of a scuba tank and soft weights and a 2.5 to 3 hour water skills refresher with our instructors during one of our scheduled pool sessions. After completion, our staff will sign off in your logbook verifying your skills review. A plastic and digital SDI Refresher C-card can be ordered if needed.

The next available pool time and date: We have availability during our pool sessions for a refresher course on: **Thursday, February 16th from 7:00 - 9:30 PM** or **Thursday, March 23rd from 7:00 - 9:30 PM** at Notre Dame Prep School in Towson.

Have your own pool? Contact us for a private refresher course for 1 to 6 divers to fit your schedule.

What equipment will you need for the in-water session? A swimsuit, towel, mask, fins, snorkel, regulator with alternate air source and SPG and BCD are required for the in-water session. Additional diving equipment is available to rent if needed.

When applicable: certification cards, logbooks, equipment rentals and additional fees:

Prerequisites: All divers should be able to swim 200 yards, style and speed are not important, and be in good physical condition.

Age limits: The age limit for a refresher class is 10 years old and many people continue diving into their 70s and 80s if they are in good health. When a Jr. Open Water diver reaches age 15, they can apply for their Open Water Diver card. If it has been more than one year since they were first certified as a Jr. Open Water Diver, a skills review session may be needed to upgrade.

Suggested equipment: The pool water is usually a comfortable 80° to 85° but can range from 72° to 90°. If you get cold easily, a 3mm wetsuit can help make your dives more enjoyable. We have a limited supply of 3mm full wetsuits available for pool sessions.

Ready to get started...

Step 1 - Complete the attached course application and the medical history questionnaire. If all of your answers are "**NO**" on your medical questionnaire then you are good to go. These forms can be emailed back or mailed to the address on the application. A deposit or full payment can be made by cash, check or credit card. We accept Visa, MasterCard and Discover. However, if there is a "**YES**" answer on your medical history questionnaire, then a physician's evaluation form may be required. This form will need to be turned in before we start any in water training with you. Both the medical history questionnaire and medical guidelines should be presented to your physician and signed to clear you to start scuba diving.

Step 2 - Set up your personal account with SDI. This account will allow you quick access to your eLearning classes, certification cards and many more features. Start by going to SDI's Register page and completing the 3 steps: <u>https://portal.tdisdi.com/register?</u>

Step 3 - Login and view your account to verify your information is correct. Then click on the "Profile" tab at top of the page. You can then upload a black & white or color photo of yourself. A top of head to top of shoulders image against a white background works best. This is the photo that will be printed on your credentials and is used for identification purposes. It will be removed and replaced with the agency logo if the following photo requirements are not met: Must show a clear view of your face. No mask, hats, sunglasses, etc. No cartoons, logos, group photos, etc.

Step 4 - When we have received your application and course deposit, we will issue you a SDI eLearning activation code so you can start viewing your eLearning course materials. There are a few ways to use this code but the easiest way is to log into your SDI account and then click the "eLearning" tab at the very top left of your page. Scroll down to the three blue boxes and enter your code into the "Enter Code" box. *The code needs to be entered exactly so copying and pasting your code works best.* Redeem code, agree to terms, submit code signup, then Start Course. Step 5 - Verify a start date and schedule for either a group or private refresher classes with us. Pay off your balance 14 days before your class starts. Hand in your physician's evaluation/release form if it was required before you start in the pool. Complete your eLearning materials before our in-water review session.

Step 6 - Before the water sessions begin, we will verify the pool's location with you, email you a copy of the training liability release form and training record to review. We will have copies for you to complete and sign when we meet at the pool session.
